Check if the truck can make turns

The truck needs adequate space of at least 12ft wide to easily access your location. Ensure that there are no fences or other obstacles blocking the truck's path when making turns.

Check that the ground is firm

Make sure the ground is firm and hard, providing a stable surface for the container and truck to drive on. Delivery cannot take place on sand or loose dirt.

Check the weather conditions

Weather conditions such as rain or snow can impact the delivery. Ensure the road and container location are dry and firm.

Ensure a flat delivery site

Avoid hills or slopes. We use tilt beds to deliver your container, therefore placing a container on an incline is impossible.

Check that your container is level

To ensure doors work properly it is essential that the container is placed on an even & level surface.

Watch out for overhead obstacles

Ensure that there are no obstructions, such as power lines or tree branches, within 16ft over the delivery area.

Check the area around the container

Make sure there is enough space in front of the container, with a length of 3x that of your container (60ft for a 20ft and 120ft for a 40ft container).

Make sure you have the area cleared

Check that there is enough space for the container by clearing a space of 20ft or 40ft in length (depending on the size of your container) by 8ft in width, free of any obstructions.

Check if the truck can make turns

Firm delivery surface



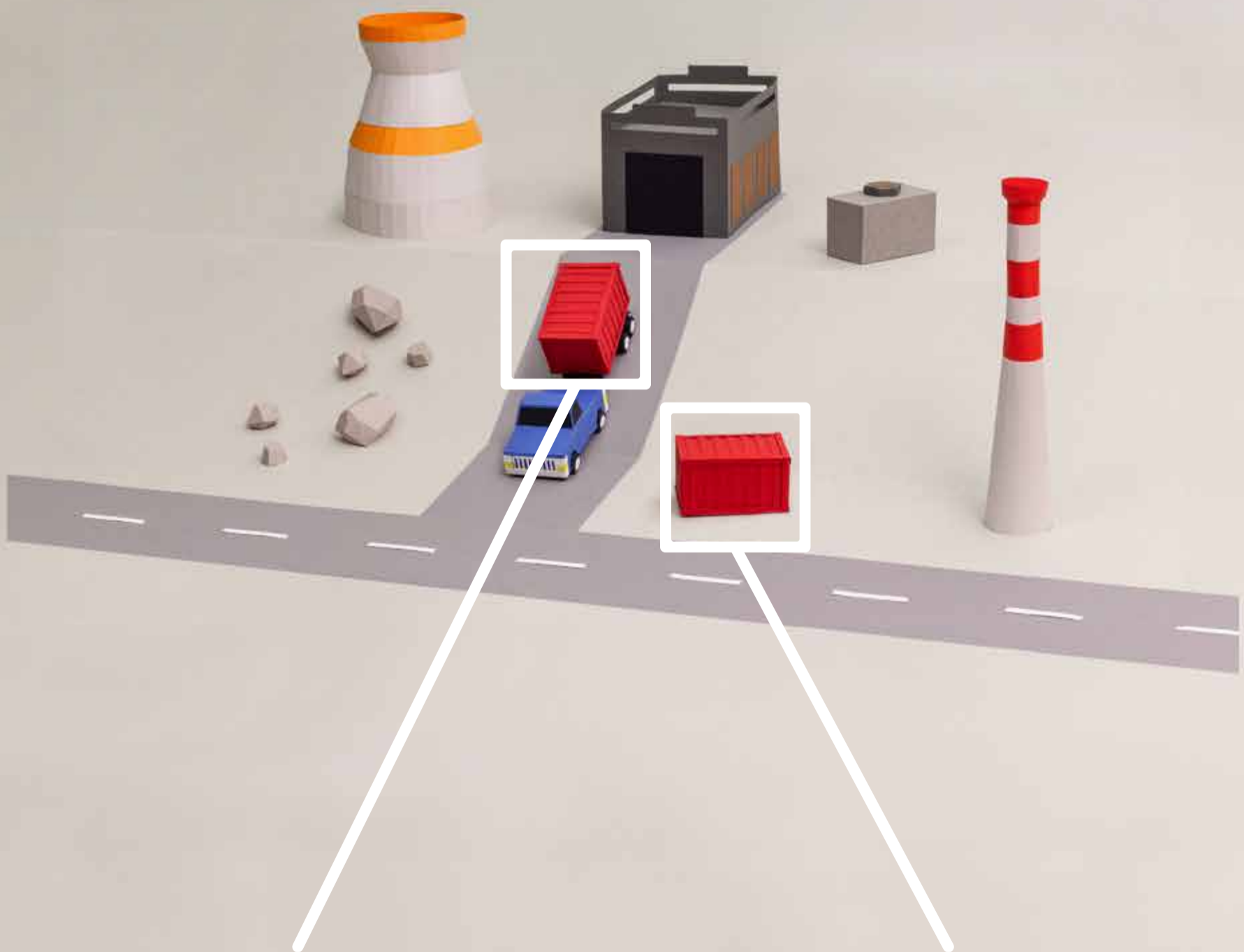
Check that the ground is firm
